Introduction

Have you ever had to wait for a long time for a promise to come true?

How do you feel when you are waiting for restrictions for COVID to go away?

How did you feel when you were waiting? Is it hard to trust while you are waiting?

Comprehension

Read 1 Samuel 18:6-9

When Saul was alive, he was Jealous of David. Why did Saul treat David as his enemy?

Read 1 Samuel 26:9-10

Why would David not fight Saul even though Saul had been trying to kill him for 8 years?

Read 2 Samuel 1:1-4

The man who came to David thought David would be pleased with him. Why?

Read 2 Samuel 1:8-12

What did the Amalekite man do to King Saul?

The man came boasting expecting David to be pleased with him. What did David do instead? Why?

How did David feel about the news that God's king Saul had died?

Now Saul is dead, who was going to be the king of God's people?

Understanding

Even when it was hard for David and his life was threatened, did he ever stop trusting God's time and take action into his own hands?

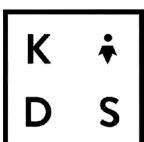
Often we can be tempted to not trust God and do what we want. What are some things that other people might say it is ok for you to do, but God says the opposite?

Application

God's king (Saul) was dead. The man who killed Saul ended up dying.

Read Luke 23:34. When God's forever king Jesus was being killed on the cross, what did Jesus ask God to do? What does that tell us about what Jesus (God's forever king) offers us?

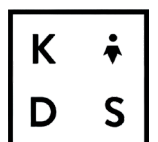
