Comprehension / Understanding

Read Hebrews 3:7-11

⁷ It is just as the Holy Spirit says,

“If you hear God’s voice today, ⁸ don’t be stubborn! Don’t rebel like those people who were tested in the desert. ⁹ For forty years your ancestors tested God and saw the things he did. ¹⁰ “Then God got tired of them and said, ‘You people never show good sense, and you don’t understand what I want you to do.’ ¹¹ God became angry and told the people, ‘You will never enter my place of rest!’”

¹² My friends, watch out! Don’t let evil thoughts or doubts make any of you turn from the living God. ¹³ You must encourage one another each day. And you must keep on while there is still a time that can be called “today.” If you don’t, then sin may fool some of you and make you stubborn. ¹⁴ We were sure about Christ when we first became his people. So let’s hold tightly to our faith until the end. ¹⁵ The Scriptures say, “If you hear his voice today, don’t be stubborn like those who rebelled.”

¹⁶ Who were those people that heard God’s voice and rebelled? Weren’t they the same ones that came out of Egypt with Moses? ¹⁷ Who were the people that made God angry for forty years? Weren’t they the ones that sinned and died in the desert? ¹⁸ And who did God say would never enter his place of rest? Weren’t they the ones that disobeyed him? ¹⁹ We see that those people did not enter the place of rest because they did not have faith.

(Hebrews 3:7-11)

What will happen if we don’t encourage each other to keep living for Jesus? (How was that like Gods people long ago in the talk?)

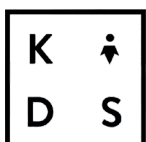
Application

What are some things you can do to help other people keep trusting in Jesus until the end?

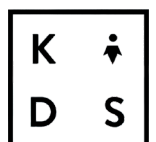

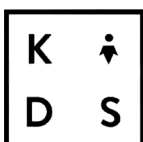

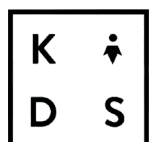
