Passage:	Luke 4:1-14

Passage:	Luke 4:14-30
Lesson Aim:	Jesus is Gods great king come to save. He wouldn't be killed here, because it
	was not the time God had planned for this to happen.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that
	Jesus was the one the whole Old Testament was looking forward to.
	 Gods timing for what would happen to Jesus was just right.
	Nothing will happen without God letting it happen.
	The time where Jesus would eventually die would be to deal with our
	sin once and for all.
	 Jesus was in complete control – and is in control now,

Week 3 (20/02/21)	
Passage:	Luke 5:1-11
Lesson Aim:	People want to push Jesus away but Jesus doesn't want to be pushed away. He came to be our friend.
Lesson Outcomes:	 We want the kids to understand that Jesus has power over all creation. Simon Peter recognised that Jesus was Gods great king. Simon Peter was sinful, just like us, but Jesus came to forgive and welcome sinners. Jesus called the fishermen to be fishers of men. We too can call people to follow Jesus.
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Car Question:	How did Simon Peter respond when he saw how powerful Jesus was?
	How were Simon Peter and the others going to fish for men?

Week 4 (27/02/22)	
Passage:	Luke 5:27-32
Lesson Aim:	Jesus came to call sinners to forgiveness. And he can forgive completely.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that
	 Jesus didn't come for people who were "good."
	Levi was so excited when Jesus included him in God's kingdom.
	Jesus came to save sinners.
	We need to realise we are sinners and come to Jesus seeking
	relationship with him. He will gladly welcome us.
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Car Question:	How did Jesus say he came for?
	How does knowing Jesus came for sinners make you feel?

Week 5 (06/03/21)	
Passage:	Luke 6:17-49
Lesson Aim:	Jesus taught us to love others the way God has loved us.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that
	 If we are true followers of Jesus then we will live our lives following him.
	 We will never be perfect, but should keep striving to live for Jesus.
	 It will be hard for us to follow Jesus.
	God will slowly change us and people will therefore see how amazing
	Jesus is.
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Car Question:	What was amazing and different about what Jesus taught the people?
	Will it always be easy for us to follow and obey Jesus?

Passage:	Luke 7:1-10
Lesson Aim:	Put your faith in Jesus' words because his words can be trusted completely.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that
	 Jesus is powerful. He does things only God can do.
	 Jesus was able to heal with only a word.
	The Centurion had amazing faith in what Jesus could do.
	Jesus can heal. He might not always heal us now, but just like the
	centurion, we can put our complete trust in Jesus.
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Car Question:	What was amazing about what the centurion thought about Jesus' authority?
	Do you think Jesus is still powerfully at work now? How?

Week 7 (20/03/21)	
Passage:	Luke 7:36-50
Lesson Aim:	The more you understand how much you've been forgiven, the more you will
	love Jesus.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that
	Simon failed to see how he really needed to receive forgiveness.
	The woman knew she was really bad and she knew she desperately
	needed Jesus to forgive her.
	The woman loved Jesus, because she was so grateful to be forgiven.
	We should love Jesus amazingly because of the amazing forgiveness
	he has given us.
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Car Question:	What did the people think of the woman?
	How did she respond to Jesus correctly?
	Has Jesus forgiven you? Do you love Jesus?

Week 8 (27/03/22)	
Passage:	Luke 8:1-15
Lesson Aim:	As we hear the word of God, the best response is to listen to Jesus and love him all the days of our lives.
Lesson Outcomes:	 We want the kids to understand that Not all people will respond the same way when they hear the good news of Jesus. Jesus wants us to be the person who hears about the good news of Jesus and says Yes and follows him. If we love Jesus we will follow him all our days.
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Car Question:	Will everyone respond the same way to the word of God? What are things that will distract people?
	How can we make sure we listen to Jesus well?


Week 9 (20/02/21)

	Is Jesus still in control of everything?





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
