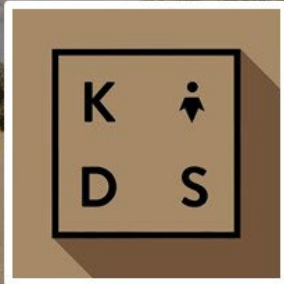
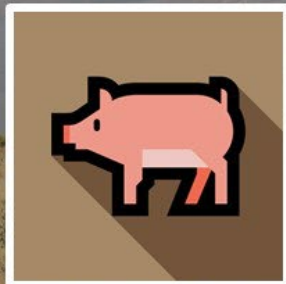

## Week 1 (06/02/21)

Passage:	Luke 4:1-14
Lesson Aim:	Jesus was tempted just like we are, but he never sinned. He is God's obedient Son.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Where all of Gods people failed, Jesus resisted temptation.</li><li>• Satan tried to trick Jesus by bending the truth.</li><li>• Jesus trusted the word of God to help him resist temptation.</li><li>• We need to trust that Jesus is the one who has beaten sin for us.</li></ul>

Car Question:	What did Jesus use to say no to temptation? Why can Jesus help us when we are being tempted?


## Week 2 (13/02/22)

Passage:	Luke 4:14-30
Lesson Aim:	Jesus is Gods great king come to save. He wouldn't be killed here, because it was not the time God had planned for this to happen.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus was the one the whole Old Testament was looking forward to.</li><li>• Gods timing for what would happen to Jesus was just right.</li><li>• Nothing will happen without God letting it happen.</li><li>• The time where Jesus would eventually die would be to deal with our sin once and for all.</li><li>• Jesus was in complete control – and is in control now,</li></ul>

Car Question:	Even though Jesus was Gods king, what did some people want to do to Jesus? Why did Jesus not die at this time?


### Week 3 (20/02/21)

Passage:	Luke 5:1-11
Lesson Aim:	People want to push Jesus away but Jesus doesn't want to be pushed away. He came to be our friend.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus has power over all creation.</li><li>• Simon Peter recognised that Jesus was Gods great king.</li><li>• Simon Peter was sinful, just like us, but Jesus came to forgive and welcome sinners.</li><li>• Jesus called the fishermen to be fishers of men. We too can call people to follow Jesus.</li></ul>

Car Question:	How did Simon Peter respond when he saw how powerful Jesus was? How were Simon Peter and the others going to fish for men?


### Week 4 (27/02/22)

Passage:	Luke 5:27-32
Lesson Aim:	Jesus came to call sinners to forgiveness. And he can forgive completely.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus didn't come for people who were "good."</li><li>• Levi was so excited when Jesus included him in God's kingdom.</li><li>• Jesus came to save sinners.</li><li>• We need to realise we are sinners and come to Jesus seeking relationship with him. He will gladly welcome us.</li></ul>

Car Question:	How did Jesus say he came for? How does knowing Jesus came for sinners make you feel?


## Week 5 (06/03/21)

Passage:	Luke 6:17-49
Lesson Aim:	Jesus taught us to love others the way God has loved us.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If we are true followers of Jesus then we will live our lives following him.</li><li>• We will never be perfect, but should keep striving to live for Jesus.</li><li>• It will be hard for us to follow Jesus.</li><li>• God will slowly change us and people will therefore see how amazing Jesus is.</li></ul>

## Week 6 (13/03/22)

Passage:	Luke 7:1-10
Lesson Aim:	Put your faith in Jesus' words because his words can be trusted completely.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus is powerful. He does things only God can do.</li><li>• Jesus was able to heal with only a word.</li><li>• The Centurion had amazing faith in what Jesus could do.</li><li>• Jesus can heal. He might not always heal us now, but just like the centurion, we can put our complete trust in Jesus.</li></ul>

Car Question:	What was amazing about what the centurion thought about Jesus' authority? Do you think Jesus is still powerfully at work now? How?


## Week 7 (20/03/21)

Passage:	Luke 7:36-50
Lesson Aim:	The more you understand how much you've been forgiven, the more you will love Jesus.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Simon failed to see how he really needed to receive forgiveness.</li><li>• The woman knew she was really bad and she knew she desperately needed Jesus to forgive her.</li><li>• The woman loved Jesus, because she was so grateful to be forgiven.</li><li>• We should love Jesus amazingly because of the amazing forgiveness he has given us.</li></ul>

Car Question:	What did the people think of the woman? How did she respond to Jesus correctly? Has Jesus forgiven you? Do you love Jesus?

## Week 8 (27/03/22)

Passage:	Luke 8:1-15
Lesson Aim:	As we hear the word of God, the best response is to listen to Jesus and love him all the days of our lives.
Lesson Outcomes:	We want the kids to understand that... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Not all people will respond the same way when they hear the good news of Jesus.</li><li>• Jesus wants us to be the person who hears about the good news of Jesus and says Yes and follows him.</li><li>• If we love Jesus we will follow him all our days.</li></ul>

Car Question:	Will everyone respond the same way to the word of God? What are things that will distract people? How can we make sure we listen to Jesus well?

**Week 9 (20/02/21)**

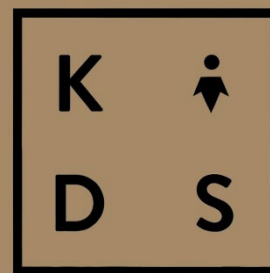
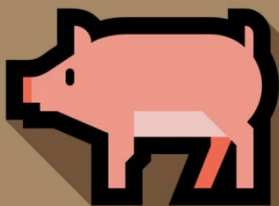
Passage:	Luke 8:26-39
Lesson Aim:	Jesus has control over everything, even demons.
Lesson Outcomes:	<p>We want the kids to understand that...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus was in control of everything – even demons.</li><li>• Jesus cared for this man and restored him.</li><li>• Not everyone will respond in trust and obedience to Jesus. Some will want nothing to do with him.</li><li>• Jesus changed this mans life and he went and spoke about what Jesus had done.</li><li>• For those who trust in Jesus – he has given us his spirit.</li><li>• Jesus is in control of all things even now.</li></ul>
